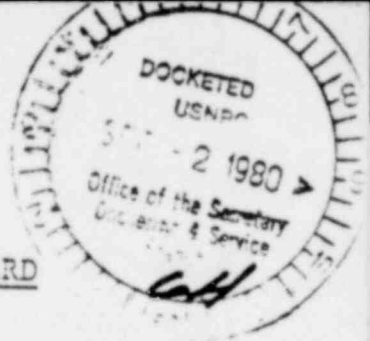

PORTER COUNTY CHAPTER INTERVENORS' NOTICE  
OF DEPOSITION OF RUSSELL BOHN

Please take notice that, pursuant to 10 CFR §2.740a, Porter County Chapter of the Izaak Walton League of America, Concerned Citizens Against Bailly Nuclear Site, Businessmen for the Public Interest, Inc., James E. Newman and Mildred Warner ("Porter County Chapter Intervenors"), by their attorneys, shall take the deposition of Russell Bohn, Manager of the Nuclear Staff of Northern Indiana Public Service Company (NIPSCO), commencing on Tuesday, September 30, 1980, at 10:00 A.M., at the offices of Business and Professional People for the Public Interest, Suite 1300, 109 N. Dearborn, Chicago, Illinois 60602, and continuing thereafter from day to day until completed, before a certified court reporter, an officer authorized to administer oaths by the State of Illinois, associated with the office of Leon M. Golding & Associates, 200 W. Monroe, Chicago, Illinois 60602. Mr. Bohn will be examined upon the following matters:

1. All matters set forth or referred in letters dated February 7, 1979 and August 31, 1979 from NIPSCO, by Mr. Shorb, to Harold R. Denton;

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2. The reasons why NIPSCO did not complete construction of the Bailly nuclear plant by September 1, 1979;

3. All matters contained in or referred to in Contentions 1, 3, 4, 5, 7, and 8 of the Joint Intervenors' First Supplement to Petition for Leave to Intervene filed in this proceeding on February 26, 1980, as admitted as contentions in this proceeding by the Order Following Special Prehearing Conference, dated August 7, 1980;

4. The identity of persons who have or may have knowledge of the matters described in paragraphs 1 through 3.


5. The existence of documents which contain information concerning the matters described in paragraphs 1 through 4.

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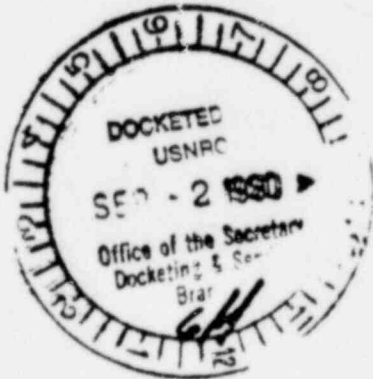
