Recently, while reviewing the District's Physical Security Plan and Security Plan Implementing Procedures (SPIP), it was discovered that a guard supervisor block was inadvertently omitted from Attachment No. 4 of the Physical Security Plan, "Typical Shift Security Force Assignment." We found that the same omission was made in Enclosure 6-3, "Security Shift Chain of Command", located within SPIP No. 6.

We have revised the chain of command chart within SPIP No. 6 and will revise Attachment No. 4 to the Physical Security Plan. The revisions will show a guard supervisor in the chain of command, located between the watch commander block and the security officer block.

The revision to Attachment No. 4 will be submitted to you later this year, at the same time we submit Amendment No. 8 to the District's Physical Security Plan. Since we refer to a guard supervisor in the written portions of both the Physical Security Plan and the Security Plan Implementing Procedures, we feel the fact that we left this position off of the organization chart does not constitute any significant change to either document.
