General Electric Company hereby requests revision of the subject certificate for the GE BU-7 transport package, for the following three reasons:

- (1) Consolidation of all prior applications for revisions and renewals.
- (2) Consolidation of all results of tests performed on the BU-7 package to verify package compliance with the requirements of 10 CFR 71 in Paragraphs 71.35 and 71.36, and Appendices A and B.
- (3) Request for a change of allowed H/U ratio in the package contents from 0.45 to 1.577.


