THE FOLLOWING HAS BEEN RELEASED TO THE MEDIA AND IS FOR YOUR  
INFORMATION. PLEASE POST FOR EMPLOYEES TO READ.

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MIDLAND, JULY 31, 1980 -- A REORGANIZATION OF THE MANAGEMENT STRUCTURE OF CONSUMERS POWER COMPANY'S ACTIVITIES AT THE MIDLAND NUCLEAR PLANT SITE HAS BEEN ANNOUNCED JOINTLY BY JAMES W COOK, VICE PRESIDENT-MIDLAND PROJECT, AND RUSSELL B DE WITT, VICE PRESIDENT-NUCLEAR OPERATIONS.

THE REORGANIZATION CREATES A SITE MANAGEMENT OFFICE WHICH COMBINES THE MIDLAND CONSTRUCTION STAFF AND OPERATING PERSONNEL OF ENERGY SUPPLY DEPARTMENT INTO A SINGLE ORGANIZATION TO BOTH COMPLETE THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE PLANT AND, SUBSEQUENTLY, TEST AND OPERATE THE FACILITY.

DONALD B MILLER, CURRENTLY SITE MANAGER FOR CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES, WILL RETAIN THAT TITLE BUT WILL ASSUME MANAGEMENT RESPONSIBILITIES FOR ALL PHASES OF THE PROJECT AT THE SITE AS HEAD OF THE SITE MANAGEMENT OFFICE. JOINING MILLER IN THE SITE MANAGEMENT OFFICE WILL BE GERALD B SLADE WHO BECOMES ASSISTANT SITE MANAGER AND PLANT SUPERINTENDENT. HE PREVIOUSLY SERVED AS PLANT SUPERINTENDENT WITH RESPONSIBILITIES FOR OPERATING THE FACILITY.

REPORTING TO THEM WILL BE THOMAS C COOKE, CONSTRUCTION SUPERINTENDENT- THOMAS W ELWARD, PLANT OPERATING AND MAINTENANCE SUPERINTENDENT- ROBERT E MC CUE, TECHNICAL SUPERINTENDENT- DENNIS D JOHNSON, SCHEDULE CONTROL SUPERVISOR- ROGER F KINNEAR, PLANT PERSONNEL DIRECTOR- NORMAN J SAARI, PLANT PUBLIC AFFAIRS DIRECTOR- VERNON M BROWN, PLANT CONTROLLER AND JOSEPH M BIELINSKI, ADMINISTRATIVE SUPERVISOR.

PREVIOUSLY COOKE, MC CUE, JOHNSON AND SAARI REPORTED TO MILLER AND ELWARD, KINNEAR, BROWN AND BIELINSKI REPORTED TO SLADE.

ESTABLISHING THE SITE MANAGEMENT OFFICE WILL CONSOLIDATE CERTAIN DUAL ACTIVITIES PARTICULARLY IN THE TESTING AREA AND ESTABLISH A SINGLE POINT RESPONSIBILITY FOR ALL SITE ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATED WITH THE MIDLAND NUCLEAR PLANT, ACCORDING TO COMPANY OFFICIALS. UNDER THE PREVIOUS ORGANIZATION RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE PLANT WOULD HAVE SHIFTED FROM THE CONSTRUCTION ORGANIZATION TO THE SEPARATE OPERATIONS STAFF AT THE FUEL LOAD DATE.

UNDER THE NEW CONCEPT THE ONSITE STAFF AND ORGANIZATION WILL NOT CHANGE AT THE FUEL LOAD DATE. THE PLANT SUPERINTENDENT WILL BECOME THE HEAD OF THE SITE MANAGEMENT OFFICE.

IT IS ANTICIPATED THAT THE SITE MANAGEMENT OFFICE WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL ALL MAJOR CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES ARE COMPLETED.

SIMILAR RESPONSIBILITY WILL APPLY IN THE UTILITY'S HEADQUARTERS MANAGEMENT STRUCTURE. PRIOR TO FUEL LOAD COOK WILL HAVE AUTHORITY FOR SITE ACTIVITIES WITH DE WITT PROVIDING STAFF GUIDANCE FOR OPERATIONAL ACTIVITIES. AT FUEL LOAD, SCHEDULED FOR JULY 1983, THESE LINES OF AUTHORITY WILL ALSO BE REVERSED.

The following organizational changes have been made within Consumers Power Company effective August 1, 1980.

1. The position of General Superintendent - Nuclear Operations has been deleted and the position responsibilities transferred to the Director - Nuclear Services.
2. A new position, the Director - Nuclear Services, has been established. The Nuclear Services Department is responsible for technical and administrative services in support of the Company's operational nuclear plants. The Director - Nuclear Services reports to the Vice President - Nuclear Operations.
3. The Quality Assurance - Nuclear Operations Department now consists of staff sections for each plant and two sections in the General Office, namely Audits and Methods and Special Projects. Each Section reports to the Director, Quality Assurance - Nuclear Operations. With the exception of the Midland Plant, the QC functions now report to the Quality Assurance organization.
