Details related to this request are contained in the attachment to this letter.



Pursuant to 10 CFR 170.31, enclosed is a General Electric check for \$150 for processing this amendment request.

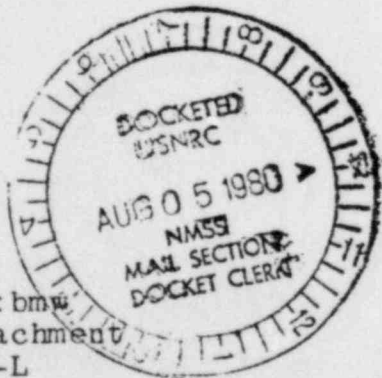
