Attached for your information as Attachment 1 is Licensee Event Report 80-17 concerning an occurrence where a piece of redundant safety-related equipment was rendered inoperable as a result of a concrete core drilling operation. This work was not part of the Trojan Control Building Modification Program authorized by condition 2.C.(12) of Operating License NPF-1 (Amendment 47, July 25, 1980), and thus was not subject to the conditions and commitments associated with that program.

As discussed in Attachment 2, we have evaluated the implications of this occurrence relative to the extensive core drilling involved in the Trojan Control Building Modification Program. We have concluded that the precautions, methods and control; required under the conditions and commitments applicable to the Control Building Modification Program provide assurance that a similar occurrence will not occur during core drilling performed for that program.
