

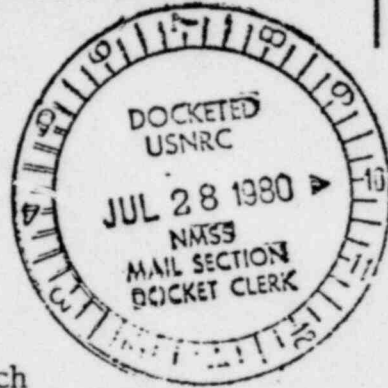



Dear Mr. Kasun:

This letter is to confirm my understanding of your interpretation of 10CFR73 that we discussed in our conversation of June 17, 1980 (Ref. 1). That understanding is that a site licensed to possess quantities of SNM requiring physical security may possess and use SNM outside secured areas provided the total quantity of SNM involved is less than a "low strategic significance" quantity (10CFR73.2(y)).
