DOCKET 50-155 - LICENSE DPR-6 -BIG ROCK POINT PLANT - RESPONSE TO IE BULLETIN NO 80-19 - FAILURES OF MERCURY-WETTED MATRIX RELAYS IN REACTOR PROTECTIVE SYSTEMS OF OPERAT-ING NUCLEAR POWER PLANTS DESIGNED BY COMBUSTION ENGINEERING

IE Bulletin No 80-19, dated July 31, 1980, "Failure of Mercury-Wetted Relays in Seactor Protective Systems of Operating Nuclear Power Plants Designed by Combustion Engineering" requested a determination of whether or not the subject relays are used in the reactor protective system (RPS).

Consumers Power Company has reviewed plant records and finds that no mercurywetted relays are in use in the Big Rock Point RPS. Therefore, no additional action pursuant to IE Bulletin No 80-19 will be taken.' Receipt of Revision 1 to the subject bulletin dated August 15, 1980 is acknowledged, but does not change our response.
