Gentlemen:

We have received a copy of your application dated May 14, 1980, for amendment of License No. DPR-66 which you filed with the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation for review. The application involves several changes to the Beaver Valley Power Station Unit No. 1 Technical Specifications and was accompanied by a Class IV amendment fee of \$12,300.

Based on information provided to us by the ONRR staff as a result of a preliminary review of your application, it has been determined that:

- the Appendix I changes and those changes identified as items (2) through (7) of the first paragraph of your application are each considered to involve a single safety or other issue and, as such, qualify for a Class IV fee (several changes of the Class III type), and
- the changes identified as items (1) and (8) of the application are each considered to be administrative in nature and thus qualify as a Class II fee.

On the basis of the above, your May 14 application involves Class IV and Class II fees. Therefore, it is requested that your Company promptly remit a Class II fee of \$1,200 to this office. If the final review of your application by the ONRR staff reveals that these fees are incorrect, an adjustment will be made.
