Dear Mr. Newman:

In response to your letter of August 22, 1980, please be advised that, during a prehearing conference on September 15, 1980 in two consolidated anti-trust cases */, there was a discussion evidencing that there is a real and imminent possibility of settlement. Thus there will be no conflicting responsibilities and no need to reconstitute either the Allens Creek board of which Mr. Wolfe is the Chairman or the anti-trust board of which Mr. Wolfe is a member.

Under these circumstances, the Allens Creek board may or may not set forward the commencement date of the hearings, and, of course, that is a matter that lies solely within the discretion of the board.
