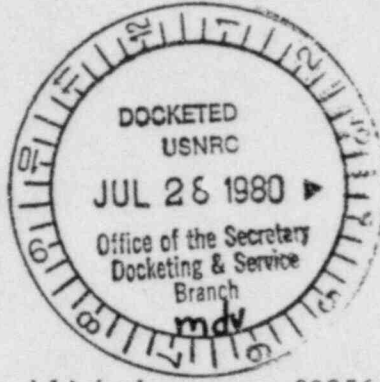

Gentlemen:

Pursuant to the proposed rule published on page 39856 of the Federal Register Vol. 45, No. 115 of 12 June 1980, the Navy concurs with the proposal to retain pocket dosimeter records for only two years instead of until the Commission authorizes disposal. Further, the Navy would favor reducing the retention period to one year instead of two years. This is based on the fact that permanent exposure records are well established before one year elapses.
