To the Nuclear Regulatory Commission:

This letter is written to acknowledge that we have given Dr. Maxine Watson, Department of Biology, Indiana University permission to conduct research involving the use of radioactivity on our property.

The property is located in Greene County, about 2 miles southwest of Hendricksville, Indiana. This is a rural area. Access to the property is via a dirt-top county road. The area is little-traveled with limited vehicular traffic and even more limited foot traffic. The portions of the property in which she plans to work are separated by electric fences from pastures in which stock animals graze.

It is our understanding that:

1. Only ^{14}C will be used.
2. The area in which experimental plants are to be located will be clearly marked with flags warning of the use of radioactivity.
3. The experiments will be carried on over a number of years.
4. At the completion of the experiments all significantly radioactive material will be removed from the site.
