## APPENDIX

## NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Pro-Technics International, Inc. Houston, Texas Docket: 30-30429 License: 42-26928-01

During an NRC inspection conducted on July 15, 1988, violations of NRC requirements were identified. In accordance with the "General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions," 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C (1988), the violations are listed below:

10 CFR 30.34(c) requires that each licensee confine its possession and use
of byproduct materials to the locations and purposes authorized by the
license. Condition 10 lists the authorized permanent locations.

Contrary to the above, the NRC inspector identified that byproduct material was stored at 11129 NW 10th Street, Yukon, Oklahoma, an address occupied by the licensee for about a year, listed in the telephone directory, therefore considered a permanent location, but not listed as such in the license.

This is a Severity Level IV violation. (Supplement IV)

 10 CFR 20.207(a) requires that licensed materials stored in an unrestricted area shall be secured from unauthorized removal from the place of storage.

Contrary to the above, the NRC inspector found that individuals not employed by the licensee or authorized by the license had keys and access to the area where licensed materials were stored.

This is a Severity Level IV violation. (Supplement IV)

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, Pro-Technics International, Inc. is hereby required to submit to this office, within 30 days of the date of the letter transmitting this Notice, a written statement or explanation in reply, including for each violation: (1) the reason for the violation if admitted, (2) the corrective steps which have been taken and the results achieved, (3) the corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations, and (4) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Where good cause is shown, consideration will be given to extending the response time.
