Response to NRC Generic Letter 89-07 Power Reactor Safeguards Contingency Manning For Surface Vehicle bombs

This letter is being provided to confirm, as required by Generic Letter 89-07, that the Prairie Island Safeguards Contingency Plan and implementing procedures have been modified to include short-term actions that could be taken to protect against attempted radiological sabotage involving a land vehicle bomb if such a threat were to materialize.

The Prairie Island Safeguards Contingency Plan and implementing procedures have been revised in accordance with the guidance provided in Generic Letter 89-07. Because the changes to the Safeguards Contingency Plan resulting from Generic Letter 89-07 do not decrease the safeguards effectiveness of the plan, the changes are being implemented without requirements of 10 CFR 50.54(p)(2), the revised Safeguards Contingency Plan is attached.
