Thank you for your letters dated April 7, 1989 and October 13, 1989, in response to our letters dated February 27, 1989 and September 11, 1989 concerning allegations pertaining to substance abuse at your Blue Ash, Ohio and Dayton, Ohio facilities (Allegation RIII-88-A-0185 and 89-A-006).

In our letters, we requested that you review the allegations, initiate appropriate investigation and take any actions you deem necessary and submit the results of your investigation to the NRC.

Your response indicated that with regard to the Dayton, Ohio facility, the allegations were partially substantiated and the employed in question was terminated. With regard to the Blue Ash, Ohio facility, you indicated that the allegations were unsubstantiated. We found your investigation to be sufficient to support your conclusions and have no additional questions regarding this matter. We request that you retain the supporting documentation for your investigation of this allegation for a minimum of one year from the date of this letter.
