During an NRC inspection conducted on October 20, 1989 a violation of NRC requirements was identified. In accordance with the "General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions," 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C (1989), the violation is listed below:


- A. 10 CFR 30.34(b) provides that no license issued or granted pursuant to the regulations in this part and Parts 31 through 35, and 39 nor any right under a license shall be transferred, assigned or in any manner disposed of, either voluntarily or involuntarily, directly or indirectly, through transfer of control of any license to any person, unless the Commission shall, after securing full information, find that the transfer is in accordance with the provisions of the Act and shall give its consent in writing.

Contrary to the above requirement, the ownership of Plant Inspection Company was transferred to U. S. Testing Company, Inc. on May 25, 1989 without securing approval of the transfer by the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

This is a Severity Level IV Violation (Supplement VII).
