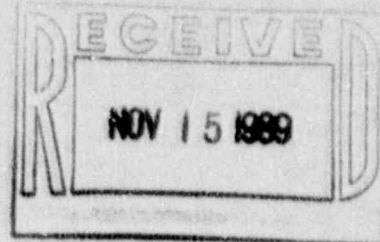

This is in response to your letter of November 1, 1989, received in my office today. This is the requested additional information for our response to your Notice of Violations dated September 21, 1989.

Our medical physicist, A.P. Turner, Ph.D., discussed your requests with Linda Kasner today. We offer the following information to help clarify our response.

1. Procedure to ensure that corrective actions remain effective and violations do not recur.

Response: An audit of items 1, 2 and 3 in our letter of response dated October 10, 1989, will be included in the periodic program reviews done by the Radiation Safety Officer to ensure that corrective actions remain effective and violations do not recur.

2. Procedures to document records of surveys of areas where radiopharmaceuticals are used.

Response: Records will be maintained of surveys of areas where radiopharmaceuticals are used as identified in item 2(b) in our letter of response dated October 10, 1989.
