Inspection Summary

Inspection on October 16-19, 1989 (Reports No. 50-266/89029(DRSS);  
No. 50-301/89029(DRSS))

Areas Inspected: Management Support; Protected and Vital Area Barriers; Access Control-Personnel, Packages and Vehicles; Alarm Stations and Communications; Power Supply; Testing, Maintenance and Compensatory Measures; Training and Qualifications; and Review of Licensee Actions on Previous Inspection Findings. In addition, the following specific areas were reviewed: Management Effectiveness, Physical Barriers-Vital Areas; Access Control-Personnel; Detection Aids-Protected Area and Safeguards Information.

Results: The licensee was found to be in compliance with NRC requirements within the areas examined, except as noted below:

Access Control-Personnel - Failure to adequately control personnel and material access through a security boundary.

In addition, corrective action for one previously identified violation was not fully effective to prevent recurrence. Additional corrective measures were requested. One weakness in the licensee's personnel/packages search program was identified. The licensee has taken adequate action to resolve our concern.

The licensee's site security program is being generally implemented in an adequate manner. Corporate and plant support for the security program is appropriate.
