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SUBJECT: DISCRETIONARY ENFORCEMENT REGARDING THE UNIT 2 REACTOR PLANT SYSTEM

This letter is in response to your November 22, 1989, letter requesting that NRC exercise discretionary enforcement regarding the Unit 2 Reactor Plant System. A copy of your letter is attached for reference.

We have reviewed the basis for your request noting that you will maintain the reactor power level at approximately 20 percent until the four hour test run is completed on the 2B Main Service Water Pump. Any pump abnormalities observed during the test run of the 2B Main Service Water Pump will result in completing the shutdown of Unit 2 to Mode 3 in a controlled fashion. This period of extension will expire at 2:15 p.m. CST on Wednesday, November 22, 1989.

This extension and the conditions detailed above were discussed with you on November 22, 1989.




