Enclosed for your information is the Run Report for the Integrated Radwaste Treatment System (IRTS) Campaign #12. This report provides details concerning the operational run of the IRTS including: process description, operational details, system performance, lessons learned and the results obtained. Campaign #12 processed 28,333 gallons of supernatant containing 232,000 curies for a cumulative total of 284,983 gallons containing 2,690,000 curies removed from Tank 8D-2.

Campaign #12 was a four column run on a C-D-A-B configuration. Column D because of its "heel" of loaded zeolite reinserted into the sequence as the second column.
