In response to a Memorandum and Order of October 24, 1989, Citizens For Responsible Government, Technical Information Project, South Dakota Resources Coalition and Catherine M. Hunt filed additional information on November 17, 1989 relative to standing in the captioned proceeding.

New information was provided pertaining to such matters as claims for standing based on the allegation of the transportation of radioactive waste near the headquarters and residences of participants. There is also contained in the new request by South Dakota Resources Coalition to have Technical Information Coalition represent the interest of South Dakota Resources Coalition to the extent the latter cannot.

Licensee Northern States Power Company has not been afforded an opportunity to respond to the supplemental filing. It is

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
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hereby granted the right to file a response within ten days of the issuance of this Memorandum and Order.

There is also pending before me the November 15, 1989 "Licensees Request For Clarification Or Reconsideration Of Memorandum and Order (Hearing Request) Dated October 24, 1989." The thrust of the pleading deals with future scheduling. It requests that the identification of the issues and the submission of written presentations should not be delayed pending completion of the environmental assessment of or safety evaluation report.

Following a determination that the request for a hearing shall be granted and the filing of the initial hearing file, the other parties will be given an opportunity to respond to Licensee's request of November 15, 1989. A decision will then be made on Licensee's request.

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
