**Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC)
Generic Letter 88-14 - Instrument Air Supply
System Problems Affecting Safety-Related Equipment**

The purpose of this letter is to provide an update to our letter dated August 31, 1989 detailing the action plan developed to respond to NRC Generic Letter 88-14, "Instrument Air Supply System Problems Affecting Safety-Related Equipment". We identified three actions to be completed at a later time. The three items are:

1. Educate current operators on the issues identified in NUREG-1275 and Generic Letter 88-14. The training was scheduled to be completed by October 1989.
2. Update license training materials for new operators to specifically cover the types of common-mode failures described in NUREG-1275 and to emphasize the importance of the air system. The update was scheduled to be completed by October 1989.
3. Revise Maintenance Procedure (MP) 12-4, "Valve Air Actuators", to include periodic maintenance inspections for in-line filter/regulators and lubricators. The revision was scheduled to be completed by September 1989.




