Relative to the regulatory concerns communicated to us in your letter of September 22, 1989, the following corrective steps have been taken:

You are formally notified that Mr. James Benetti of our staff has taken over the responsibilities of Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) for this license. Mr. Benetti holds a Master's Degree in Physics, with specialized training in Health Physics from the University of Wisconsin, and has worked for the State of Wisconsin Radiation Protection Section for five years before joining the Federal government in 1987. He has worked in the capacity of Health Physicist for the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) and the United States Department of Energy, Chicago Operations Office, since moving to Chicago. He has been named in Wisconsin's license (# 48-07436-04) to possess radioactive materials. He has been informally serving in the capacity of RSO since his return to USEPA in April 1989, however, due to our oversight USNRC was not informed. He has now been formally named to serve in this capacity. He can be reached at, FTS 886-6175.

In accordance with the provisions of our license, we have returned to a semiannual calibration of the instruments used to perform radiation surveys of our cesium source. The most recent calibration of these instruments was performed on September 11, 1989.
