The Commission is being asked to approve a final rule in this paper which provides for the sequestration of witnesses compelled by subpoena to appear in connection with NRC investigations or inspections.

The amendment also provides for the exclusion of counsel for a subpoensed witness when that counsel represents multiple interests and there is reasonable basis to believe that such representation will prejudice, impede, or impair the integrity of the inquiry.

All Commissioners have approved the final rule as attached, again, to our memorandum of November 28th.
