This letter is being written in response to your letter of September 26, 1989.

Robert Schiff remains at this location as the person specifically trained in the use of the four (4) sealed Cesium 137 gauges located in fixed locations at this plant. All service such as maintenance and leak testing is now done by Process Automation Business, Inc., on a semi annual basis. I believe that Robert Schiff meets the training requirements of the Radiation Protection Officer.

On our renewal of Material License 48-10859-01 the change in the Radiation Protection Officer was inadvertently omitted. I assumed that Robert Schiff would be the Radiation Protection Officer as both he and Karl Edstrom were listed as trained personnel on previous licenses. After being made aware of the problem, I have contacted Process Automation Business, Inc., a subsidiary of Combustion Engineering, Inc., to provide the specific training necessary to meet the NRC licensing requirements. This training is scheduled to take place in December.

After the training is complete we plan to submit an amended license application to cover any changes not included in the renewal application.
