SUBJECT: EARTHQUAKE IN KAILUA, HAWAII

At approximately 1117 local time, December 5, 1989, an earthquake occurred in Hawaii. The earthquake was reported to be 4.6 on the Richter Scale with an epicenter 25 miles northeast of Kailua, Hawaii.

Region V was notified of this event at 1555 PST, December 5, 1989 by a FEMA representative. At that time, Castle Medical Center was contacted. Although the earthquake was felt, no damage was reported.
