GPU Nuclear Corporation ("GPUN") has been collaborating with the Nuclear Management and Resources Council, Inc. ("NUMARC") to prepare comments on the referenced Draft Regulatory Guide DG-1001, "Maintenance Programs for Nuclear Power Plants," 54 Fed. Reg. 33988 (August 17, 1989), in response to the request by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC"). We have performed a detailed review of the draft guide and have provided comments to NUMARC through GPUN's member on the NUMARC Ad Hoc Advisory Committee on Maintenance, established for this purpose.
