Electric Power Research Institute (EPRI)
upcoming application to have at least
one-third of all commercial nuclear
plants waste declared "Below Regulatory
Concern." (BRC).

I disagree with this deregulation,
I feel it threatens the health & safety
of the public & the environment.

Considering the Nuclear Regulatory
Commission's past record and disregard
for public safety, and their own sub-
Standard regulations, I feel that this
deregulation is unreasonable & dangerous.

I realize that radioactive waste
storage is a complex issue & one of
the biggest problems our country faces
today. However, this policy to declare
the waste BRC is only an attempt
by the Nuclear Industry to avoid
safe disposal of their waste. ->

Simply lowering the standards
of what is safe waste will not
solve the issue and presents
only more problems for the future.
(the landfills having to deal with
the waste as well as possible
elimination of consumer products
that produce such waste.)

I ask that you do not accept
this deregulation. Deny the EPR's
