SUBJECT: CRYSTAL RIVER UNIT 3 - RESEARCH PROJECT ON TRAINING-RELATED PERFORMANCE INDICATORS

This letter is to request FPC's cooperation in discussing with NRC contractors (Science Application International Corporation and their consultant, Ms. Rita Graham) an NRC research project to identify and evaluate trainingrelated performance indicators. One of the purposes of this work is to better understand and explain how training affects plant safety in a systematic manner.
