Dear Ms. Fort:

The U.S. Muclear Regulatory Commission (MRC), Office of Muclear Material Safety and Safeguards, is currently preparing a supplemental environmental impact statement on decommissioning the Kerr-McGee Chemical Corporation's inactive thorium plant located in West Chicago, Illinois. As required by the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969, the study will evaluate Rerr-McGee's proposed disposal plan and reasonable alternatives of the plan to serve as a basis for MRC to take licensing active related to decommissioning the site.

The purpose of this letter is to request your edvice as to whether we should consider as one of the elternatives the transfer of the West Chicago vastes to an existing uranium will tailings site in New Mexico for personnel disposal. At present, the West Chicago site contains about 160,000 m² of ore residues, contaminated soils, inormals building rubble, and contaminated equipment.
