1.	Receive notification from RCDC via pocket voice pager.	
2.	Receive notification Police Officer On Duty or On Call via phone, pager or runner. If the Police Officer On Duty or On Call is unavailable, the Emergency Management Director will make this notification. Give Police Officer exact information as to how you can best be contacted.	
3.	If notification from Police Officer On Duty or On Call or Emergency Management Director is not received within 15 minutes, attempt to contact them. If unable to do so, implement the notification sequence outlined for the Police Officer On Duty or On Call.	
4.	Verify with the Emergency Management Director that the EOC will be opened to provide access for key staff with emergency responsibilities.	
5.	Report to the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) in the Fire Station and initiate Form 120Q, Emergency Log Sheet.	
6.	Request the Emergency Management Director obtain an current event status from NHOEM. If the Emergency Management Director is unavailable to obtain the status, information should come from NHOEM by telephone over the Emergency Management Radio located at the Kensington EOC (use Form 300E, Local Liaison/Communications Status Form for status reports from NHOEM).	
7.	Consult with other key town officials and determine of further action should be taken.

8.	If you decide to fully activate the EOC, inform the Police Officer On Duty or On Call, or other town officials that need to be notified.	
9.	Review procedures for SITE AREA EMERGENCY and GENERAL EMERGENCY.	
10.	If no further action is deemed necessary, stand by for notice of escalation or termination of event.
