
Dear Dr. Autry:

This responds to an April 23, 1991, letter from Bob Martinez, Director, Office of National Drug Control Policy, in which he requested that I send you a copy of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC's) current Drug Testing Plan.

Enclosed is a copy of the NRC's current Drug Testing Plan. Our most current list of testing designated positions begins on page A-4 of the Plan. We have made only one change to the Plan since the Secretary of Health and Human Services certified to Congress on August 16, 1988, that our Plan was in compliance with Executive Order 12564 and applicable provisions of law. On January 9, 1989, Appendix D was added to amplify the Statement of Policy and add minor clarifications to three other passages in the Plan.

We plan to update and modify our Plan in the near future. As such, we will submit the Plan to your office for advisory review by the Interagency Coordinating Group.
