
The agenda for the Thursday and Friday, September 4 and 5 sessions of the September 4-6, 1980 meeting of the Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards, announced in the Federal Register on August 22 (45 FR 56217), has been changed as follows:

- 1) Thursday, September 4, 1980 -- 8:30 a.m. - 9:30 a.m.--Opening Session
- 2) Friday, September 5, 1980 -- 1:30 p.m. - 2:30 p.m.--Meeting with NRC Chairman and Other NRC Commissioners

The authority for such closure is Exemption (9)(B) to the Sunshine Act, 5 U.S.C., 552b(c)(9)(B).
