NOTICE OF ISSUANCE OF AMENDMENT TO CONSTRUCTION PERMIT

Notice is hereby given that the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has issued Amendment No. 1 to Construction Permit No. CPPR-145. The amendment reflects the addition of Cajun Electric Power Cooperative, Inc. as a new co-owner of the River Bend Station, Unit 1 (the facility). An application to add Sam Rayburn G&T, Inc. as an owner is still being reviewed by the Commission and, if approved, will be the subject of a further Federal Register notice. Gulf States Utilities Company has sole responsibility for the design and construction of the facility, which is located in West Feliciana Parish, Louisiana.

The application for the amendment complies with the standards and requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended (the Act), and the Commission's rules and regulations. The Commission has made appropriate findings as required by the Act and the Commission's rules and regulations in 10 CFR Chapter I, which are set forth in the amendment.

Prior public notice of the amendment was not required since the amendment does not involve a significant hazards consideration.


