Gentlemen:

Enclosed is renewed Source Material License No. SUA-1249, which has been revised in its entirety, authorizing the Homestake Mining Company (HMC) to conduct a research program for the recovery of uranium from mine water at or near the LaSal Mine, Big Indian District, San Juan County, Utah.

This license is being re-issued as a renewal of a Source Material License granted initally with an expiration date of May 30, 1979 but contains revisions to the previous license conditions.

Although our review indicates that the project does not involve any environmental or safety considerations which could potentially preclude license renewal, due to the uncertainty of HMC's planned operations, the information provided by HMC to date is of insufficient scope and detail in several areas. Accordingly the renewed license is subject to new conditions requiring the submittal of such information by HMC, and approval by the NRC, prior to operations or construction of the associated evaporation pond. The license has also been conditioned to require the implementation of a defined in-plant radiation safety program prior to commencement of operations.
