Gentlemen:

This refers to the meeting conducted by Mr. W. M. McNeill of this office on July 29, 1980 at our office in Arlington, TX on the report of inspection and your response with Mr. W. C. Wheadon.

This meeting was held to verify the corrective and preventive actions of General Electric in response to Inspection Report 71009001/80-01 (99900321/80-01). Mr. W. C. Wheadon established this meeting. He provided the records which were necessary to close the open findings. As you know, the NRC requires each of its licensees to assume full responsibility for the quality of specific products, components, or services procured from others. You should therefore not conclude that the NRC's inspection exempts you from inspections by an NRC licensee or his agents nor from taking effective corrective action in response to their findings.

Within the scope of this meeting, we found no instance where you failed to meet NRC requirements.

In accordance with Section 2,790 of the Commission's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter together with the enclosed meeting report will be placed in the Commission's Public Document Room. If this report contains any information that you believe to be proprietary, it is necessary that you make a written application within thirty (30) days to this office to withhold such information from public disclosure. Any such application must include a full statement of the reasons on the basis of which it is claimed that the information is

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
