The Commission has issued the enclosed Amendment No. 50 to Facility Operating License No. NPF-1 for Trojan Nuclear Plant. The amendment consists of changes to the Technical Specifications for fire protection systems in response to your License Change Applications (LCA) 57 (Revision 1) and LCA 59 (Revision 2) both dated June 19, 1980. The balance of the requested Technical Specification changes contained in LCA 57 (those not involving fire protection) are still under review and will be the subject of a later licensing action.

The amendment revises the Technical Specifications related to fire protection by the addition of operability and surveillance requirements for new equipment added pursuant to the Trojan fire protection review published with Amendment No. 22 dated March 9, 1978. The amendment also contains miscellaneous changes pertaining to fire protection. The issuance of this amendment and related supplement to the Fire Protection Safety Evaluation Report completes the NRC's fire protection review for the Trojan facility.

Our original Fire Protection Safety Evaluation Report (SER) of March 9, 1978 identified seven incomplete items, five of which were resolved in a supplemental SER issued on March 25, 1980. The enclosed final SER documents the resolution of the two incomplete items which remained.

As to implementation of the fire protection modifications, we understand through discussions with your staff and the NRC resident inspector that all modifications required by license condition 2.C.(8) have been completed. Implementation of the remaining items will have to be completed in conformance with the schedule contained in the new fire protection rule, 10 CFR 50.48, when the rule becomes effective.


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A copy of the Notice of Issuance is also enclosed.
