Millstone Nuclear Power Station, Unit No. 1 Proposed Technical Specification Changes for Scram Discharge Volume System

Pursuant to 10CFR50.90, Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO) hereby proposes to amend its operating license for Millstone Unit No. 1 (DPR-21) by incorporating the attached changes into the Technical Specifications. These proposed changes are in response to the NRC's request as stated in Reference (1).

The enclosed "Description of Changes and Safety Evaluation Summary" should provide sufficient information for the NRC Staff to review and approve the recommended changes to the Technical Specifications.
