MANAGEMENT OF WORK OBTAINED UNDER THE DOE/NRC MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR GOODS OR TECHNICAL AND RESEARCH SERVICES.

I. Purpose

This Bulletin provides guidelines which promote effective and efficient planning, execution, closeout and documentation of work placed with the DOE under the DOE/NRC Memorandum of Understanding (MOM) dated February 24, 1978. Key procedures and essential elements of cost and management information are specified. To support various phases of the work.

II. Scope

This Bulletin applies to all Offices including Boards, Panels and Committees of the NRC.

Elements of Cost

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1. Direct scientific/professional labor cost and associated manhours

This provides an indication of the amount of technical effort expended to produce the desired product

2. Direct support labor and associated manhours

This cost should be segregated from item: (1) so that item (1) can stand out. Also this labor is usually at a lower cost per unit

- 3. Fringe benefits associated with direct labor
- Material, supplies, and noncapitalized equipment
- 5. ADP costs
- 6. Subcontracts
- 7, Capital Equipment
- 8. Lirect travel

- 9. Indirect cost including labor
- 10. G&A if separate from item (9)
