1. Reference your inspection and notice of violation conducted 16 May 1980. Review of contents in Appendix A, the violation stated appears to be in error. As stated in our conversation, during the inspection, it was indeed that Gerald E. Barbour and Terrance C. Alexander were no longer assigned or located at McGuire AFB as Radiological Protection Officers. Roger A. Loomis named on page one (1) of Amendment No. 01 as alternate is presently assigned and was fulfilling the duties of the Radiological Protection Officer. SGT Loomis at this date, is transferring to another base. SGT Greer is his replacement. MSG John A. Werner is no longer acting as Radiological Monitor for the 108th CAMRON. MSG James J. Dobrowolski is now acting as Radiological Monitor for the 108th CAM Sq.

2. The following steps have been taken to correct violation of Commission Rules and Regulations, ie. limiting use or supervision of licensed material to named persons.


- (a) Completed Industrial Radiography Course at Chanute AFB
