Gentlemen:

We have reviewed and accepted the Fundamental Nuclear Material Control Plan submitted on August 29 and September 8, 1980. This Plan covers the material control and accounting activities for the decommissioning and decontaminating of the highly enriched uranium facility.

In order to ensure complete compliance with the requirements of 10 CFR 70.58, we have found it necessary to require that your material control and accounting program be strengthened in certain respects. Accordingly, new conditions are being added to your license. Some of these new conditions were discussed with Mr. Gregg of your staff on September 19, 1980. In order to incorporate the new conditions and withdraw obsolete conditions, Sections 1.0 through 8.0 of Amendment MPP-2 to Special Nuclear Material License No. SNM-777 are hereby revised, as set forth in the enclosure, effective immediately.

We have determined that your submittals of August 29 and September 8, 1980 contain information of a type specified in 2.790(d). Accordingly, pursuant to Section 2.790(d)(1), such information is deemed to be commercial or financial information within the meaning of 10 CFR 9.5(a)(4) and shall be subject to disclosure only in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 9.12.
