As a result of the August 27, 1980, meeting between NRC staff and Commonwealth Edison Company personnel at your Bethesda office, Mr. J. Lombardo of the NRC staff requested Commonwealth Edison to submit three copies each of the following information:

"Equipment Environmental Qualification Review Responses to Draft Interim Technical Evaluation Report for Zion Station Units 1 and 2, September 19, 1980."


