Millstone Nuclear Power Station, Unit No. 1 Proposed Technical Specification Changes Required for Reload 7 Refueling Outage

Pursuant to 10CFR50.90, Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO) hereby proposes to amend its operating license for Millstone Unit No. 1 (DPR-21), by incorporating the attached changes into the Millstone Unit No. 1 Technical Specifications. The changes would permit return to full power operation following the seventh refueling outage, scheduled to commence October 4, 1980.

The enclosed "Description of Changes and Safety Evaluation Summary" should provide sufficient information for the NRC Staff to review and approve the changes on an expedited schedule such that we may implement them by the end of the refueling outage, which is scheduled for the first week in December.

Since this change is reload-related, it is considered to be a supplement to the Reload 7 licensing submittal which has been sent under separate cover (Reference (1)). The Reload 7 licensing submittal contains a number of additional proposed specification changes. The appropriate Class IV type of amendment fee, pursuant to 10CFR170, is \$12,300 for the reload submittal, which was enclosed with Reference (1). Thus, there is no additional fee required for changes proposed in the letter.

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Again, this change is required to permit Cycle 8 startup, the first week in December, 1980. Should you have any questions, please contact us.
