Thank you for your timely letter of March 14, 1992, on your opposition to blanket, extended long-term on-site storage of low-level radioactive waste. Your letter was received soon after the letter from Mr. Kemp Houck, editor of "Atoms & Waste."

As you know, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission encourages, through Generic Letter 81-38, licensees who wish to store for longer than five years to apply for a 10 CFR Part 30 byproduct license for storage. This licensing action will help ensure that licensees install safety features which are adequate to protect the public health and safety, and the environment.

We expect to be issuing a Federal Register notice on a proposed rulemaking on low-level waste storage in the near future. This action is a result of our consideration of the public comments on our storage policy and questions related to storage noticed in the Federal Register in December 1990. In the proposed rule, we will be proposing that licensees exhaust other reasonable waste management options before storage will be permitted after January 1, 1996. The use of storage is to be considered as an option of last resort. We will be seeking public comment on the proposed rule and we encourage you to comment.
