- ① What ions (species) are in solution?
- ② What is the concentration of these ions?
- ③ ~~Are~~ ^{Are} there solids suspended?
- ④ What methods will be used

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to clean up this water? I don't want to know any secret details on the proposed clean-up but only in general - ion exchange? evaporation? R.O.? precipitation? or what? to remove these (I assume) ~~not~~ radioactive ions & solids.

Mr. Martin forwarded my letter to the Office of Nuclear Regulation of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission but I have had no reply.
