Dear Mr. Peterson:

General Atomic Company makes application for amendment to subject license to allow us to export nuclear components and parts to Taiwan. These components and parts are replacements for items previously supplied to the THOR research reactor facility located in Taiwan.

Our application, reference (a), requested license to export specific reactor components falling under 10 CFR 110 Appendix A(9). We now have need to expand the license to include other nuclear components and in that and other categories, namely, nuclear reactor designed parts and components as in 10 CFR 110 Appendix A(a)(2)(3)(8) & (9) and A(a)(10) parts and components for sub-categories above. More specifically, these would include control rod elements, control rod drives or parts thereof, fission and ion chambers, electronic amplifiers and preamplifiers, etc., used in monitoring reactor power level, fuel handling or measuring equipment, etc. We expect the total value of these exports to be approximately \$70,000.

The parts and components being shipped do not constitute major parts of a utilization facility for which a utilization facility license is required, i.e., the components are sub-components of major assemblies categorized therein.

We have an urgent need to ship the fission chambers and would appreciate your expediting this amendment. If you should have questions regarding this matter, please contact me at (714) 455-2823.
