Dear Governor Thornburgh,

I do not want my college student to return to Franklin and Marshall College at this time. I am sure that other parents whose children go to colleges in this area will feel the same way.

Even though they say the amounts vented out will be within safe limits, I believe, ⁱⁿ "cumulative effect." This radioactivity will add on to what is already within the area's water supply and ground, and into the people's bodies, and who knows what this accumulated amount will do? There must be a safer method to solve the problem of T.M.I. Economics and speed should not be the deciding factors.
