



Considering that the lives, health and safety of thousands of Pennsylvanians have already been endangered by the Three Mile Island power plant and the incompetency of its operators, I feel that the time allotted to the people to study and comment on the NRC's Environmental Impact statement is inadequate. I would strongly urge the NRC to extend the deadline from 45 days to 90. This would give the citizens a fair opportunity to obtain the document, study its contents, and make informed, responsible statements on the TMI clean up. Anything less is a violation of our safety and peace of mind, both of which have been severely abused in the past year and a half.
