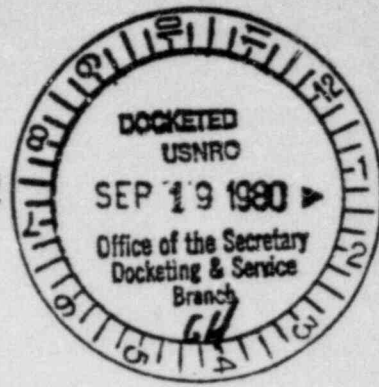

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

1. All matters set forth or referred to in letters dated February 7, 1979 and August 31, 1979 from Northern Indiana Public Service Company, by Eugene M. Shorb to Harold R. Denton;
2. The reasons why NIPSCO did not complete construction of the Bailly nuclear plant by September 1, 1979;
3. All matters contained in or referred to in Contentions 1, 3, 4, 5, 7 and 8 of the Joint Intervenors' First Supplement to Petition for Leave to Intervene filed in this proceeding on February 26, 1980, as admitted as contentions in this proceeding by the Order Following Special Prehearing Conference, dated August 7, 1980.
4. The identity of persons who have or may have knowledge of the matters described in paragraphs 1 through 3.
5. The existence of documents which contain information concerning the matters described in paragraphs 1 through 4.



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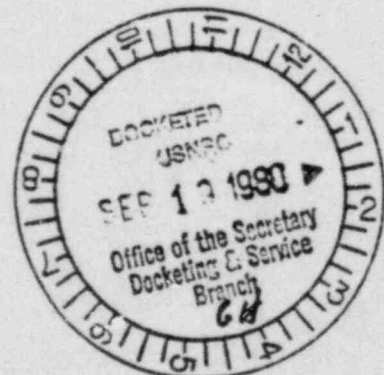
