UNWGM-EEI RESPONSE TO FILING OF
ENVIRONMENTAL COALITION ON
NUCLEAR POWER

Along with its Cross-Statement in this proceeding the Environmental Coalition on Nuclear Power (ECNP) included a "Motion Filed Consequent Upon and as Part of the Cross-Statement of ECNP."^{*/}

Although denominated a "Motion," the filing appears to contain no more than ECNP's suggestions concerning the future conduct of this proceeding. Under the Presiding Officer's May 29, 1980 Order, such suggestions are currently due from participants by October 6, 1980. The suggestions that will be filed by that date by UNWGM-EEI will indicate the defects in ECNP's suggestions.

^{*/} The document was stapled to the copy of the ECNP Cross-Statement served by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission on UNWGM-EEI. However, it was undated and unaccompanied by a certificate providing proof of service, by ECNP, on the participants in this proceeding.

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Accordingly, UNWVG-EEI takes the position that consideration of the EGNP filing should be held in abeyance until such time as it may be examined along with the submittals of other participants.

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
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
